Athens		Athens County	Village of Chauncey Bikeway Connector	\$299,707.00	\$224,780.00	The project will add approximately .3 miles of 10-foot-wide bikeway from the Hockhocking Adena Bikeway along River Road, across the Hocking River, to the Village of Chauncey on Main Street (State Route 682).
Butler	City of	Monroe	Great Miami River Trail	\$1,300,000.00	\$500,000.00	This project will complete a 2.25 mile section of the Great Miami River Trail through the City of Monroe. The trail will be a paved, 10-foot-wide multi-use path that borders the Great Miami River.
Cuyahoga	City of	Solon	Solon to Chagrin Falls Trail	\$998,416.00	\$499,208.00	The City of Solon is proposing to construct approximately 2 miles of multi-use trail, which is a part of the "Solon to Chagrin Falls" trail. This trail commences at SOM Center Road, in downtown Solon, and then progresses eastward along the former railroad right-of-way to a point immediately south of the City of Bentleyville.
Cuyahoga	City of	Euclid	Euclid Waterfront East Link Trail	\$806,525.00	\$500,000.00	The Euclid Waterfront East Link Trail builds upon the western phase of the Euclid Waterfront Connector Trail by constructing a quarter-mile shared-use public trail and trailhead along the Lake Erie shoreline. This connects planned and existing trails to a new city lakefront park with access to Lakeshore Boulevard at East 246th Street.
Cuyahoga	City of	Bay Village	Cahoon Basin Trail	\$543,885.97	\$360,262.00	This project consists of a 10-foot-wide 1,060 linear foot shared-use trail through Cahoon Memorial Park in the City of Bay Village. The asphalt trail is in a natural wooded corridor adjacent to Cahoon Creek with riparian views and expansive views of Lake Erie.

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Delaware		Orange Township	Lewis Center Road Trail-Phase III	\$447,500.00	\$300,000.00	Phase III of the Lewis Center Road Trail will construct 2,610 linear feet of 10-foot-wide asphalt trail providing access to Alum Creek State Park.
Delaware	Village of	Galena	Galena Brick Trail Phase III	\$488,408.21	\$366,306.00	The Galena Brick Trail Phase III will construct 3,550 linear feet of 10-foot-wide asphalt trail, which is a part of the Ohio to Erie Trail.
Delaware		Preservation Parks of Delaware County	Sandel Acquisitions of Ohio to Erie Trail	\$661,266.00	\$492,000.00	This project will acquire 3.7 miles of rural, wooded railroad corridor which will provide a connection to the Meredith State Trail section of the Ohio to Erie Trail.
Delaware		Orange Township	Lewis Center/North Road Trail	\$379,800.00	\$275,000.00	This trail project calls for the construction of a 10-foot-wide trail along portions of North Road and Lewis Center Road. This trail section will connect to approximately 1,850 linear feet of trail on North Road and 1,425 linear feet of trail constructed on Shanahan Road. The addition of this trail will complete the trail along North Road and Lewis Center Road and will connect to the newly constructed 22-acre Orange Township Park.
Erie	City of	Sandusky	Sandusky Bay Pathway	\$1,075,948.80	\$493,946.00	The proposed trail consists of approximately 2,110 linear foot of 10-foot-wide shared-use trail through Landing Park. This trail is Phase I of the Sandusky Bay Pathway Master Plan, which is a reimagination and repurposing of the land spanning from Castaway Bay to Plum Creek along the Sandusky Bay coastline.
Hamilton	Village of	Mariemont	Murray Bike Trail	\$358,461.00	\$268,846.00	The proposed project will construct a 1,900 linear foot, 10-foot-wide bike path along a former trolley car corridor along Murray Avenue in Mariemont.

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Mahoning		Canfield Township	Robert H. Neff Memorial Bike Trail	\$261,155.00	\$195,867.00	The Robert H. Neff Memorial Bike Trail will connect the Canfield Township Community Park to the Mill Creek Metroparks Bikeway, giving safe access from the bikeway to the park. The Neff Land Development Co. will donate a permanent easement to the township, and the Mahoning County Career and Technical Center will also donate an easement to the township.
Miami		Miami County Park District	Northern Miami County Trail Phase I: Fletcher to Garby Big Woods	\$921,233.00	\$500,000.00	This project will construct Phase I of the Northern Miami County Parks Trail system: Fletcher to Garby Big Woods Reserve. A shared parking lot at Champaign Landmark in Fletcher will serve as a trailhead, and a 1.9-mile-long, 10-foot-wide asphalt separated path will proceed west on an abandoned railroad corridor. The trail will continue south along Casstown Sidney Road, within the road right-of-way, into Garby Big Woods Reserve.
Ottawa		Ottawa County Commissioners	North Coast Inland Trail	\$2,418,000.00	\$217,162.00	This project will extend the existing North Coast Inland Trail in Elmore, starting at the bridge over the Portage River and continuing 3.82 miles northwest along an abandoned railroad line to Veteran's Memorial Park in the Village of Genoa.
Portage		Portage Park District	Headwaters Trail	\$385,000.00	\$288,750.00	Headwaters Trail Phase VII: Infirmary Road Connection is the extension of the existing 8-mile Headwaters Trail from its western terminus to a public road. Currently the trail ends approximately 300 feet from the road. The project includes engineering and construction of an embankment up to the road, and extension of the trail as a side path within the road right-of-way. This terminus at Infirmary Road brings trail users to a safe intersection with Mennonite Road. Future extensions west through Aurora are planned.
Preble	Village of	Camden	Community Walking Path	\$637,255.00	\$499,955.00	This project calls for the construction 7,100 linear foot of 10-foot-wide asphalt trail along the east side of U.S. 127, from South Street north to Camden Avenue.

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Scioto	City of	Portsmouth	Riverfront Multi-Use Path	\$873,063.00	\$187,738.00	Construction of approximately 1.6 miles of 10-foot-wide paved shared-use path within the right-of-way of Front Street in central Portsmouth and the Shawnee State University campus. The path will connect neighborhoods east of Shawnee State University, the central city, downtown businesses, city offices, marinas, campgrounds and parks along the Ohio River waterfront, and highlight the murals on the land side of the floodwall and Alexandria Point Park.
Stark		Stark County Park District	Iron Horse Trail	\$556,261.20	\$417,195.00	This project will construct 1.74 miles of 10-foot-wide pedestrian/bike trail within the City of Alliance using crushed limestone, asphalt and concrete surfacing.
Tuscarawas		Ohio and Erie Canalway Coalition	Towpath Trail	\$507,500.00	\$380,625.00	This project will include the construction of .25 miles of trail connecting the McDonnell Trailhead on the Stark/Tuscarawas border to the existing Towpath Trail north of Boliver. This new section will utilize the existing Towpath Trail as well as the historic Ohio and Erie Canal.
